Nomination for Bombay Psychiatric Society Silver Jubilee Award (Best Paper of the conference):

c) This or substantially similar paper has not been published or been submitted for publication in any scientific journal.

d) The paper has not been earlier presented at any other conference.

e) Consent from all authors about submission of the paper and a certificate that there is no copy right infringement in the contents of the paper.

f) None of the author has won the same awards in the immediate preceding year

g) Ethics clearance (where appropriate) has been obtained from appropriate ethics committee/ review board.
