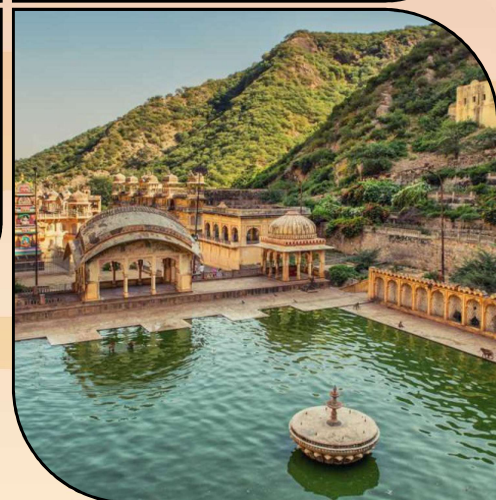
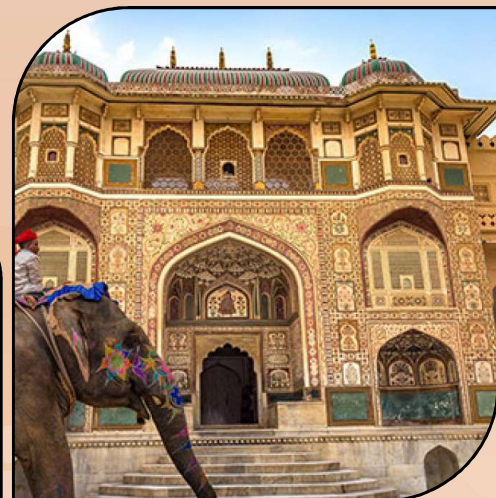

AWARD PAPERS

Members desirous of submitting their research work for award paper presentation should send it to Chairman Awards Committee, Dr. Arshad Hussain on arshadtina@gmail.com, latest by 31st "August 2022".

Dr. A K Kala Award: This award is given for original research in Biological Psychiatry. There is no age bar. Award money is Rs. 2500.

Dr. Buckshey Award: This award will be given to the paper presented by the member of the Indian Psychiatric Society-North Zone who is not above 35 years of age at the time of presentation. Award money is Rs. 1000. The paper must be accompanied with proof certifying age of the presenting author.

Dr. G.C. Boral Award: There is no age bar. Award money is Rs. 1000.

Bombay Psychiatric Society Silver Jubilee (BPSSJ) Award: All the award papers can compete for the BPSSJ award. The authors, if they desire to compete for this award, should send a declaration about their desire and willingness to compete for the nomination for the BPSSJ award.

Free papers (i.e the papers other than the award papers) can also compete for the best paper award to the nomination for BPSSJ award. For this, the authors of the free paper must submit soft copy of the full text of their paper along with the declaration as explained above, to the chairpersons, Awards committee. This submission will have to be in addition to the soft copy of abstract of the free paper to be submitted to the President, Indian Psychiatric Society-North Zone.

N N WIG ORATION

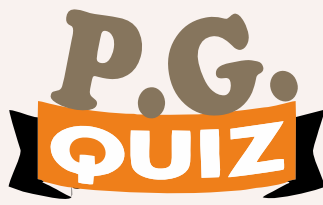

Greetings!

Nominations are invited for N N Wig Oration of Indian Psychiatric Society-North Zone for year 2022 from eligible fellows of Indian Psychiatric Society-North Zone. Nominations may be sent via email to Chairman Awards Committee, Dr Arshad Hussain on his email arshadtina@gmail.com latest by 31st August 2022. The oration will be delivered during next Annual Conference of IPS-North zone to be held in 2023. Please go through guidelines for eligibility and send your nominations.

GUIDELINES

1. The oration award will be declared one year in advance at every Annual National Conference of Indian Psychiatry Society - North Zone.
2. Any Fellow of IPS-NZ with at least 10 years of professional standing can propose the name of any other Fellow of IPS-NZ for the oration.
3. The nominee should be a Fellow of IPS-NZ at least for last 10 years with good professional standing and should be above 50 years of age.
4. The proposal including three copies of the bio-data of the nominee must be submitted to the Chairperson, Awards Committee by a date determined by the Executive Council of IPS-NZ. The proposal must be accompanied by a written consent of the nominee. In addition to 3 copies of the proposal, soft copy of the proposal MUST be submitted to the Chairperson.
5. A panel of judges shall rate the nominations. The contribution of the nominee in the field of mental health shall be the basis for rating. The nomination securing the highest total marks (out of 100) shall win the oration, subject to ratification by the Awards Committee and the IPS-NZ executive council. In case of tie, the short listed nominations shall be re-assessed by another panel of three judges. The nominee must get at least 50 marks out of 100 to the oration.
6. Final evaluation would be done as per the following guidelines:
 - Contribution to development of mental health in India - 30 marks
 - Contribution to IPS North Zone: 25 marks As office bearer, Organising and attending IPS-NZ activities, Presenting Papers / Chairperson in IPS NZ activities, Presenting Award Papers and any other significant contribution to IPS NZ.
 - Overall research contribution: 20 marks (2 marks for non pubmed journal and 4 marks for pubmed journal.)
 - Experience/ seniority in the profession: 15 marks (Half mark for each year after passing MD after 50 years of age)
 - Awards and honors by professional associations: 10 marks (one mark for an award by state/ zonal body, 2 marks for a national award and 3 marks for an international award)
7. The selected oration paper will become the property of the IPS-NZ and shall be published in the Journal of Mental Health and Human Behaviour with necessary editorial corrections. The speaker will pass on the oration paper to the Editor, Journal of Mental Health and Human Behaviour within 2 weeks of the last date of the annual conference for publication in the Journal.
8. The speaker can choose any topic related to psychiatry for the oration. He shall intimate the title of the oration to the Chairperson, Awards Committee at least three months prior to the Conference.
9. No person shall win the Award more than once.



- Eligibility- The PG students in psychiatry will be eligible for the quiz after due registration for PG quiz & submission of certificates from respective HOD.
- All eligible students have to register themselves separately for PG quiz up to 15th September 2022 along with conference registration.

There will be total 3 steps of quiz

STEP ONE



WILL BE CONDUCTED ONLINE

- There will be 30 multiple choice questions and time for this will be 20 minutes.
- There will be no negative marking in this step.
- The dates and time will be informed through conference website.
- Top 50% of participant will be eligible for step two.

STEP TWO



WILL BE CONDUCTED ONLINE

- This will also be for 20 minutes.
- 30 multiple choice questions with 1/4th negative marking; means 4 marks will be awarded for correct answer and minus 1 will be awarded for each wrong answer.

STEP THREE



WILL BE IN PERSON

- Which will be conducted during conference.
- Top 6 participants of step 2 who will qualify for step 3 shall be provided twin sharing basis accommodation and second AC train fare or economic airfare Whichever is less, on production of actual travel ticket or boarding pass.

There will be total 4 rounds during step 3

FIRST ROUND

- There will be multiple choice questions for each participant.
- There will be no passing of question in this round.

SECOND ROUND

- Will be of case vignette based multiple choice questions and there will be no passing of questions.

THIRD ROUND

- Will be of direct question and first question will be asked from the participant selected by lottery.
- There will be 30 second to answer the question. If participant doesn't respond the question will pass to the next participant.

FOURTH ROUND

- Will be Rapid fire round.
- Time allotted for each participant will be 2 minutes and maximum 5 questions will be asked .
- Each question will carry one mark and there will be no passing of the question to the next participant.

The first winner will be awarded by Rs.11000/- and the first runner up will be awarded by Rs.5100/- along with certificate.

In all circumstances the Final Decision will be of Quiz incharge

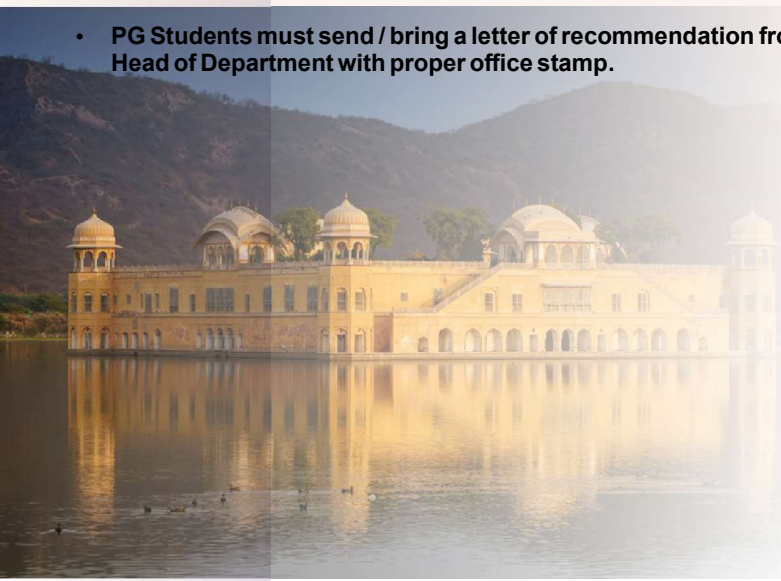

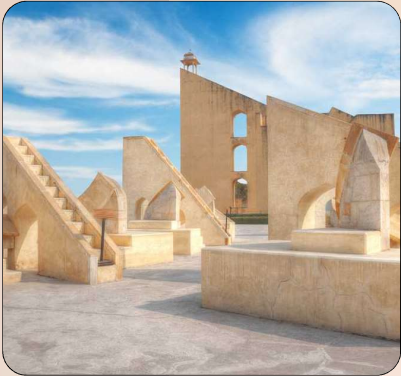
Albert Hall Museum

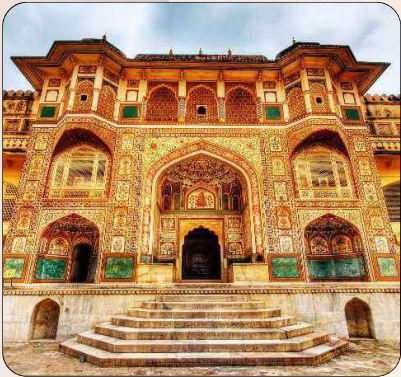
Galtaji Temple
